Location: Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center, Dayton, Ohio 45428. Take the Gettysburg Avenue or Liscum Drive exit via Route 35.

Check-in and Registration: 7:00 am - 8:00 am in Building 305 (Recreation Building), Theater. Wheelchairs manual & motorized start 5 minutes prior to race start.

Awards: 1st male and female \$50 (add \$50 if course record), 1st male and female (40+) \$40 (add \$40 if course record). Top 3 in following age groups receive medals: 10 and under, 11-14, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80 & up, top 3 walkers male and female, wheelchair/manual and wheelchair/motorized. Awards will also be given to the youngest and oldest pre-registered runner in the 5K.

Fees: Pre-registration is \$20, which includes a short sleeve t-shirt. Deadline for registration is May 13, 2017. Late registration ends at 8:00 am the day of the race and is \$25. No refunds! (Shirts, if available, are \$5.00) **Kids' Run** (Age 10 and under) – Free
